Any difference between the income and expenses will be settled up after the meeting with the Rebel Corps covering 2/3 of any shortfall and the Senate covering the remaining 1/3.

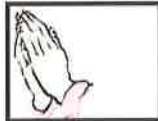
## Chaplain's Report
