## From the Commander

It has been a busy trimester for your Corps officers! I sincerely hope we are representing you well!

### Bylaws

Attached to this newsletter you will find a couple of revisions that your Long Range Planning Committee have proposed for the bylaws. I know it seems that we have bylaw corrections at each trimester meeting, but please know that we are trying to make our organization a stronger organization.

These changes have three purposes: 1) the changes will allow future Corps executive committees to set meeting dates and locations that don't necessarily correspond with the Georgia Jaycees. This has become necessary since the Georgia Jaycees don't have a third trimester meeting, which is our elections meeting; 2) we are adding back the elections committee which was dropped several bylaws revisions back; and 3) we have corrected a potential problem in the qualifications of offices that could have been interpreted that a candidate must have completed a full year in an office to run for a higher office. 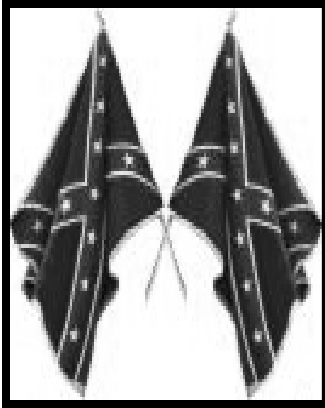

The following changes to the Georgia Jaycee Rebel Corps bylaws have been approved by the Long Range Planning Committee and will be presented at the September Board Meeting.

The purpose of the changes are to 1) remove the requirement that trimester meetings **MUST** be held at the same time as Georgia Jaycees , 2) add the elections committee back into the bylaws and 3) correct the qualifications for offices that would require that an officer candidate must complete all requirements before running for other offices. *Changes are underlined and in bold. Go to the website to see the entire document.*

### ARTICLE III · MEMBERSHIP AND NOMINATIONS

**Section 6.** Induction of new Colonels will be held at each trimester **at the Georgia Jaycees Board of Directors'** meeting.

### ARTICLE VI · OFFICERS AND ELECTIONS

**Section 3.** The officers of the Rebel Corps shall be nominated at a special called Rebel Corps Meeting to be held (in conjunction with the nomination of officers of the Georgia Jaycees) within 45 days of the Announcement date at a time and location set by the Commander. (will be elected at the September Board Meeting and installed at the annual Jaycee State Convention.) The elections will be held at the Corps second trimester meeting at a time and location set by the Commander. Officers will be sworn in at the third trimester meeting at a time and location set by the Commander. No announcements or nominations shall take place prior to July 1.

**Section 7:**

**ADD: (4) The elections committee shall consist of the three immediate Past Commanders (depending upon availability) with the Immediate Past Commander serving as Chair. The elections committee will be responsible for handling all aspects of the elections including seeking qualified candidates, qualification of candidates, conducting the election, counting votes, and any other election related procedures as deemed necessary by the Commander. The elections committee will be the final authority to certify the election.**

**Section 8. Qualifications of Officer Candidates.**

- (a) The Commander must have served **or is serving** as either the treasurer or adjutant **and** either the active or inactive vice commander.
- (b) The Vice Commanders must have served **or is serving** as either the Treasurer or the Adjutant.
- (c) The Adjutant must have served **or is serving** in at least one appointed office in the Rebel Corps or another of the Georgia Jaycee Auxiliaries. Expertise with newsletters and/or web design is desirable.
- (d) The Treasurer must have served **or is serving** in at least one appointed office in the Rebel Corps or another of the Georgia Jaycee Auxiliaries and must have had experience as a Treasurer.

### ARTICLE VII · MEETINGS

**Section 1.** The Rebel Corps shall meet three (3) times a year **at times and locations approved by the Commander and the Board of Directors.**

**Section 2.** The Rebel Corps shall hold such additional meetings as are approved by the Corps, called by the Commander **or State President**, or by a majority of officers of the Corps. **or by the State Executive Committee**

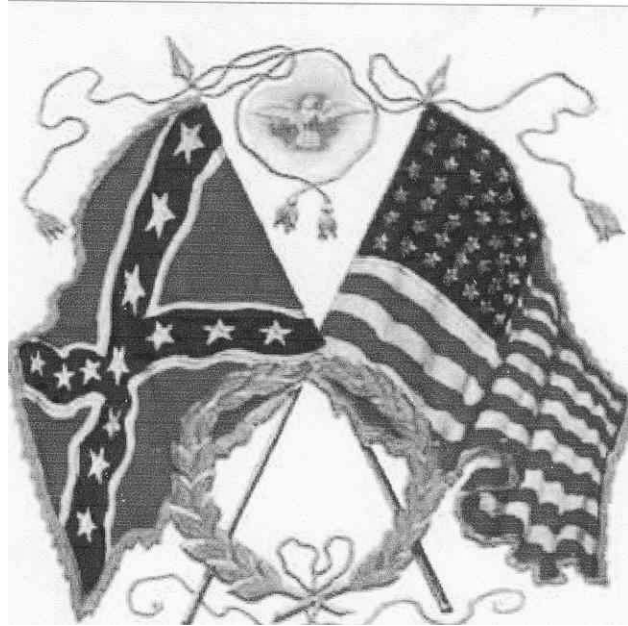
## Chief of Staff

## GEORGIA JAYCEE REBEL CORPS FOUNDATION

*Proposed Bylaw Changes – September 2010*

*The following bylaw changes have been proposed for the Foundation. Changing **Fees** to **Dues** puts us in line with IRS Regulations. The addition of directors and appointed officers be life members is at the pleasure of the board.*

*According to the bylaws, the body can only vote to accept or reject.*

Removals are in brackets [ ]. Additions are underlined.

### Section 3. LIFE MEMBERSHIP [~~FEES~~] DUES AND TIME OF SERVICE

### Section 5. DIRECTORS AND APPOINTED OFFICERS

#### A. DIRECTORS

Three (3) Directors, who should be Life Members.

B: The Board shall appoint a Secretary and a Treasurer. The Secretary and Treasurer will serve one-years terms that can be reappointed. Both secretary and treasurer must have been a Colonel at least five years and should be Life Members.
